- Act in a silly or dangerous manner

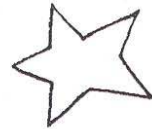
By following these 'do's and don'ts' you will be making sure that your journey and the journey of others is safe and comfortable

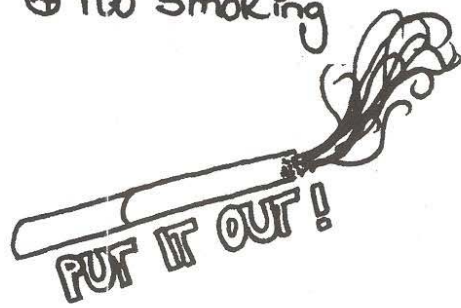
② Don't stand while the bus is moving

⑥ have respect for the bus driver

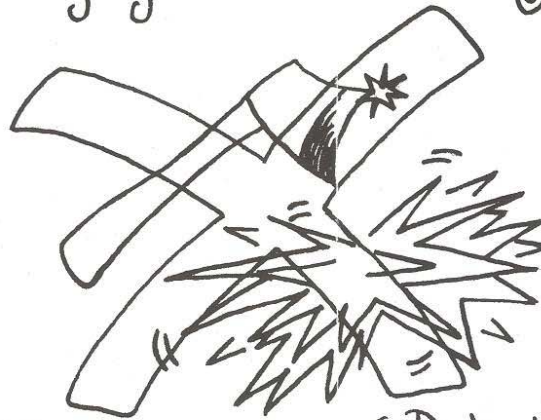

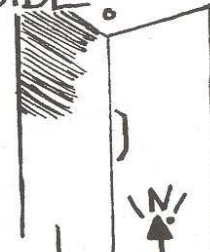
⑦ Don't damage the bus in anyway

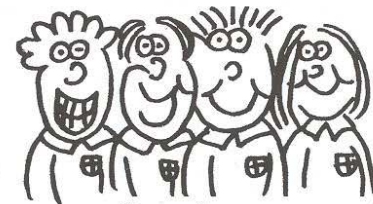
